

Medical Records

All children who attend CC+, must be up to date on their immunizations. Children should also have received lead testing and vision testing. New student's immunization history must be submitted prior to the start of school. Documentation from your child's physician must be provided to Ms. Stacey or Ms. Patty. A health record is kept in the day care center for every student.

Food Allergies

If your child has any food related allergies, please be sure to let Ms. Stacey or Ms. Patty know immediately. Any medications that are needed, including emergency medications must be provided to Ms. Stacey or Ms. Patty along with a consent form from your child's doctor.

Medications Dispensed at School

Per RI Rules and Regulation; medications, **including**, over the counter medications such as Tylenol, Motrin, or Tums, cannot be carried or distributed without a physician's consent form. This policy pertains to **ALL** students regardless of their age. If you child has a condition that may require him/her to need any medication (chronic headaches, braces), please complete and submit the consent form at the beginning of the school year. Medications must also be in their original containers labeled with the child's name and dosage as well as the expiration date. If you need a consent form, please see Ms. Stacey or Ms. Patty.
